'Feed the Keys' Food Drive Moves to May

Florida Keys – May 17, 2024, marks the third annual "Feed the Keys" Food Drive hosted by United Way of Collier and the Keys (UWCK). Through this effort, we continue to honor the memory of beloved Monroe County commissioner, restaurateur, and UWCK Local Advisory Board member, "Mangrove" Mike Forster, and his commitment to supporting Keys residents.

As part of "#Be Like Mike," "Feed the Keys" is the largest community-wide food drive aiming to augment the supply of nutritious foods available at local pantries as the school year ends. Working with food pantries to best meet the needs of the community, UWCK is moving this critical project to May, rallying the community to support Monroe County families and children who lack access to school-provided meals during the summer months.

Leah Stockton, Keys Area President of United Way of Collier and the Keys, stated, "We aim to honor Mike's legacy through this annual event, inspiring people to give back in a manner that was deeply meaningful to him - ensuring everyone in our community is fed. Monroe County has the highest cost per meal in Florida and that present challenges for our families, particularly during school breaks when access to free meals is limited. This effort aims to ensure no child in our community goes hungry this summer."

The community is encouraged to collect non-perishable food items leading up to May 17th. In the previous year, 8,099 pounds of food were donated. Now, UWCK aims to surpass that, setting a goal of 10,000 pounds for 2024. On the day of the event, UWCK will collect donations at participating partners: Burton Memorial Church in Tavernier, Keys Area Interdenominational Resource (KAIR) in Marathon, and Star of the Sea (SOS) Community Kitchen in Key West, from 2 pm to 6 pm. Community members can also drop off their donations at several collection sites Keys-wide, which will be announced shortly.

Additionally, we are introducing a virtual food drive from May 1st through May 17th at https://givebutter.com/feedthekeys. to collect monetary donations. Contributions will honor Mike's and UWCK's commitment to feeding the Keys during times of need.
