UWCK-UAE Coral Reef Learning Exchange Kicks Off in February

United Way of Collier and the Keys (UWCK) is excited to embark on a groundbreaking learning exchange with the United Arab Emirates (UAE) from February 3-8. This initiative marks a significant international collaboration, as UWCK and leading coral reef experts embark on an official <u>delegation</u> from the UAE Embassy in Washington, DC to the UAE for a week of exchange, exploration, and engagement.

The delegation, led by Dana Al Marashi, Head of Cultural Diplomacy, Embassy of the United Arab Emirates, Washington, DC, includes UWCK President & CEO Tiffani Mensch, Keys Area President Leah Stockton, Reef Revitalization Project Liaison Jessica Dockery, Communications & Engagement Manager Alissa Hudak, and selected marine biologists and coral restoration experts from across the U.S. and its territories.

Traveling to Dubai, Abu Dhabi, and other key sites, the group will participate in high-level discussions, hands-on reef restoration experiences, and cultural exchanges designed to strengthen global conservation efforts. This collaboration builds on a five-year partnership between UWCK and the UAE, focused on revitalizing the Florida Keys through coral reef restoration and beyond.


