FEBRUARY 2020

United Way of Collier and the Keys (UWCK) announced a \$3.5 million gift from the United Arab Emirates (UAE) to fund cutting-edge and innovative projects in reef restoration and education.

MAY 2021/FEBRUARY 2022

2021: Initial funding announced for local non-profit organizations: Reef Renewal USA for Sombrero Reef and Coral Restoration Foundation for Carysfort Reef.

2022: Additional funding announced for Reef Renewal USA to begin restoration work on Looe Key.

SEPTEMBER 2022

UWCK was a presenting sponsor of the Reef Futures Conference, the premier event uniting global coral restoration experts to share innovative techniques and scale-up restoration efforts.



Over the past 4 years, Marine Science Education Grants have reached 19,484 students with \$97,589 in funding, while Marine Science Educational Advancement Scholarships have supported 16 students with \$68,685.
