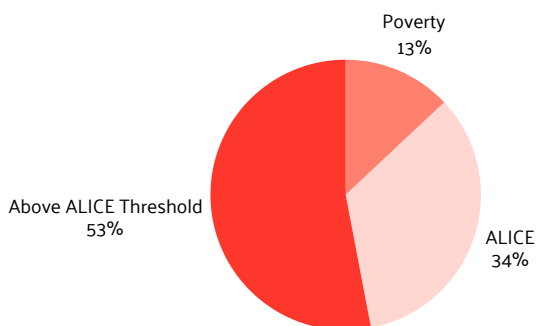




WE DO MORE THAN JUST RAISE FUNDS

WE SERVE OUR ALICE RESIDENTS

- ALICE stands for Asset Limited, Income Constrained, Employed. These are individuals and families who work hard but struggle to make ends meet, earning too much to qualify for public assistance programs yet not enough to afford the basic cost of living.
- 43% of Collier and 45% of Monroe’s households are at or below the ALICE threshold.
- Of Florida’s 8.9-million households in 2023...
 - 13% earned below the Federal Poverty Level (FPL)
 - 34% were ALICE, in households that earned above the FPL but not enough to afford the basics in the communities where they live
 - Together, 47% of households in Florida were below the ALICE Threshold

Through our free **Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA)** program, we helped 682 people receive a total of \$384,624 in tax refunds in 2025—money that goes right back into the pockets of local families.

Our Monroe **Success by 6** program offers childcare tuition assistance, reducing daily preschool costs so children can access quality early education while parents are able to maintain employment.
